Important Notice Sword Care

High Carbon Steel Sword Blades are Prone to Rust.

Although your sword has been refurbished any previous corrosion to either sword or scabbard may return over time which bears no consequence on our craftsmanship.

Carefull handling, regular maintenance and correct storage conditions must be adhered to in order to reduce the risk of future or reoccurring corrosion. Please contact us if you require advice specific to your pattern of sword.

Any rusting sword returned to us after refurbishment will be chargeable.

(A) Do not store the sword in a Nickel scabbard.

Do NOT leave a carbon steel blade in a scabbard or it may rust.

(B) Regularly keep the blade greased.

When not in use the blade should be dried thoroughly with a cloth and lightly covered in light oil, Vaseline using a stiff paint brush or silicone spray to reduce the risk of corrosion. The blade should be checked regularly thereafter, old grease removed and new re-applied

(C) Minimise touching the blade

Acids from the fingers may etch into carbon steel .

Wipe any finger prints from the blade immediately with a cloth before re-greasing.
For long term storage, keep or display your blade out of the scabbard.

(D) Do not leave a wet blade in a scabbard.

If it should be raining during parade ensure the blade is dried at the earliest possible opportunity and allow the scabbard to dry out thoroughly.

(E) No form of abrasive or cleaning products is advised for the cleaning of swords. Please contact us for advise.
